



Data Protection Statement

A Partnership with Africa is committed to protecting your personal data and respecting your privacy. We collect and process personal information in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the Data Protection Act 2018, and other applicable Irish and EU data protection laws.

What information we collect

Depending on your relationship with us, we may collect personal information such as:

- Name and contact details
- Postal and email address
- Telephone number
- Donation and payment records
- Volunteer information
- Event registration details
- Correspondence with us
- Any other information you choose to provide

We only collect personal information that is necessary for our charitable purposes.

How we use your information

We use your personal data to:

- Deliver our charitable services and activities
- Manage volunteers, supporters and donors
- Process donations and issue receipts where required
- Communicate about our work, events and fundraising (where permitted)
- Meet our legal and regulatory obligations
- Maintain accurate financial and administrative records

We process personal data only where we have a lawful basis to do so, including consent, contractual necessity, legal obligation, or our legitimate interests as a charity.

Sharing your information

We do not sell your personal information.

We may share personal data with trusted service providers who help us operate our charity (such as payment processors, IT providers or professional advisers), but only where appropriate safeguards are in place and only for the purposes of providing those services.

We may also disclose information where required by law or by a competent regulatory authority.

Keeping your information secure

We take appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data against unauthorised access, loss, misuse or disclosure. Access to personal information is limited to those who need it to carry out their duties.

How long we keep your information

We retain personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected, to comply with legal obligations, or to resolve disputes. Records are securely deleted or destroyed when they are no longer required.

Your rights

Under data protection law, you have the right to:

- Request access to your personal data
- Request correction of inaccurate information
- Request erasure of your personal data where applicable
- Request restriction of processing
- Object to certain processing activities
- Request the transfer of your data where applicable
- Withdraw consent where processing is based on consent
